## Youth and School Awards

### Open to All Students in Putnam County

(Those in Public Schools, Private Schools and Home Schooled)

The Upper Cumberland Quilt Festival Board, in an effort to encourage young people to study and learn about the art of quilt making, is offering recognition awards for students and schools in 2010. Awards will be made during the 22<sup>nd</sup> Upper Cumberland Quilt Festival, September 17-18, 2010 in Algood, TN.

Two classes of awards are being offered: 1) Student Recognition and 2) School Recognition. Awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each area and both ribbons and cash awards are being offered in both categories.

#### Student Recognition (Two Separate Classes of Awards)

- 1) Individual Quilt Square, any material, any pattern, any design, drawn or stitched, 12" X 12".

Awards: 1<sup>st</sup> Ribbon and \$25 2<sup>nd</sup> Ribbon and \$20 3<sup>rd</sup> Ribbon and \$10

- 2) Wall Hanging, not less than 20"X20" and not larger than 36"X36"

Awards: 1<sup>st</sup> Ribbon and \$25 2<sup>nd</sup> Ribbon and \$20 3<sup>rd</sup> Ribbon and \$10

#### School Recognition (One Award Class)

Group effort of two or more students (not limited to any maximum number of students)

Multiple Quilt Squares or Wall Hanging or Bed Quilt, drawn or stitched, any size and must be more than a single quilt block/square.

Awards: 1<sup>st</sup> Ribbon and \$50 2<sup>nd</sup> Ribbon and \$35 3<sup>rd</sup> Ribbon and \$25

All entries must be the work of students. Teachers may give support and guidance but should not contribute directly to the art work. All entries must be submitted for judging no later than Monday, September 13, 2010. Entries may be taken earlier to the Algood Community Center if teachers and students prefer to submit them before the school year ends in the Spring.

Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form signed by the student and their teacher. Teachers will sign for the school recognition entries.

All entries will be returned to the school; however, the Upper Cumberland Quilt Festival reserves the right to retain the winning entries for further display and marketing of the event after which all entries will be returned to the individual/teacher/school.

Entries will be judged on: Creativity 25%; Workmanship 25%; Difficulty 25%; and Appeal 25%
